I know of a person who dealt with heavy pain. Her biological dad lived in one nation while she and her siblings lived in another. Growing up was hard. What happened to her to cause her to hurt herself? Her real pain of how things were going was seemingly too much to bear, and within this wounded soul, there was a craving for some way to show others the pain level dealt with.

What did this young person deal with? Abandonment, painful sexual invasion, the trauma of verbal and emotional abuse, and strong handling of adults who left bruises on her fleshly way.

What child would deal with this painful plan and still hope a real God is up there? Would there be a God who would look at her and care about what she dealt with? Did King Jesus show up on a white horse, telling the hurting one that He will make it all better and slay those who hurt her? No. The opposite happened. He trained me to have a deep craving for His Spirit to fill the painful way of treatment dealt with. Growing up in a Christian home will not guarantee a loving environment. My mom struggled, but she was not a single mother.

I did not know love until a day at the altar that I will never forget if I had a choice. I stood there over two decades ago, praying and hoping that My God would care about me because of how others treated me. I was heavily immersed in self-pity that even if King Jesus stood in front of me, I would not think He cared. And that would explain why most of the time, He did not answer my requests for Him to come and materialize.

Where was faith in my life? My doubt ruled based on being continually let down and dealing with my hopeless feeling ways.

What happened at the altar? A married couple came to me and started ministering. They fought against an emotional wall built up, and they wondered why I would not embrace what they said about God. Yahweh was real to the people in Scripture or to the one who gave sermons, but would He even care about my current situation when it seemed He didn't care when I gave new scars to this temple of His. The couple worked on me and tried to get me to heal. But it wasn't until they said some words to me that a change came within.

They said, "Just receive His love."

I did not think it would be so easy yet hard due to my emotional wall, keeping others from getting close to me.

Could God's love be there with you, and all that needs to be done is that you receive Him? I kept a distance from King Jesus because I thought He would judge me just as others in my previous ways. But all can come to Him, asking for a new plan to live.

(5) For Moses writes of the righteousness that is based on the Law, that the person who performs them will live by them. (6) But the righteousness based on faith speaks as follows: "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will go up into heaven?' (that is, to bring Christ down), (7) or 'Who will descend into the abyss?' (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead)." (8) But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart"—that is, the word of faith which we are preaching, (9) that if you confess with your mouth Jesus *as* Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; (10) for with the heart *a person* believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation. (11) For the Scripture says, "Whoever

believes in Him will not be put to shame.” (12) For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same *Lord* is Lord of all, abounding in riches for all who call on Him; (13) for “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”
