Preacher: We were at the church, casting out demons.

Skeptic: Scripture doesn't say that Christians can have a demon. How can you cast demons out of a Christian?

YAHWEH:

Seersgate, share your thoughts on this placement.

SUSANNA SEERSGATE:

I look at all of the ways that we can give theological answers, but would it be possible for a cleaned-out human to have fresh fillings of what they had, plus greater surgings that are worse?

(43) "Now when the unclean spirit comes out of a person, it passes through waterless places seeking rest, and does not find it. (44) Then it says, 'I will return to my house from which I came'; and when it comes, it finds it unoccupied, swept, and put in order. (45) Then it goes and brings along with it seven other spirits more wicked than itself, and they come in and live there; and the last condition of that person becomes worse than the first. That is the way it will also be with this evil generation."

—Matthew 12:43-45 NASB

SEERSGATE:

Satan doesn't cast out Satan. So, Yahweh had to remove the devils. And if Yahweh gives an expelling plan, He gives a person a livable plan to be under Kingdom order.

YAHWEH:

So, if Yahweh is bringing Kingdom order, would I give Satan a plan that rules over Yahweh? Why would a house be emptied and not replaced with a governing plan? When Yahweh gives expelling and brings real order, would I fail in making the house sealed from evil?

Let Me bring a clear way of looking at the plan. How many leaders were under the Law or grace and didn't have a trait that, if left unkept, would take on a hindering trait? And would the way become a spiritual sickness that harbors a safe hub for Satan to work through?

Let's take a look at how a demon called *Gossip* has leading ways in church leaders: They will gather and say how they need another person's way of looking at things to bring their way of seeing into a form of truth. Look at how one person can influence strong ways to bend in their way with logic. They say, "Let's tell a story, and let's take a look at all we once knew. Doesn't it look as if what was spoken could not happen?" Then a multitude of "counselors" would state their way and would take funneled information into Satan's nests.

A Christian can open their house and let Satan's way slowly take territories that will bring infiltration from the enemy. Free will is still within the Christian's way, and living under the grace way, under Kingdom culture, will not bring a sealing off from Satan, bringing in weaknesses through a way of abuse of Scripture.

Can Satan cast out Satan? Why would he? But can there still be infiltrations of evil by using Christian ways of prayer and counsel details? Yes. Very well so. The way should become clear: Grace will not make a person sin less. The power from the Great Holy Spirit will bring a drawing into living under Kingdom order with an understanding that man will still sin.

So, what needs a understanding? Christians in the Kingdom will still choose sin. How can those who drink and eat of the Great King Jesus succumb to falling away? It's the inner chipping away based on how influencers bring their way of what is perceived as truth.

The many snares are able to be an inner chain. So, Yahweh would have to sweep and bring order to how a Christian lives. Think about needing expelling ways as this: would a new soul just pray the sinner's prayer, asking for a forgiving way, and then never pray to have forgiveness?

If sin can overtake and bring a falling away, would that make it clear there will also be opportunities to have demons?

A constant expelling is needed. And don't think that Satan doesn't know real Scripture and how to yield ways with that Scripture and bring his way to infiltrate.
