

LAYING ON OF YOUR HANDS IN MINISTRY

SEERSGATE SHARES THROUGH EXPERIENTIAL TRAINING:

Laying on of your hands is a vital part of any belief in religious circles. Most truly do not know why they would take on this detail other than to say it would be good to give others a good, well-wish when they leave that way. But is there truly a more profound plan? Should the laying on of hands be viewed as more?

Let's start with a need to state a major warning: Do not lay hands upon any in a casual manner. Do not take within yourself other spirits you cannot say are from the Great Way. Be aware of the *spirit* within the person who is laying hands upon you. Who can know but God, what spirit fills another?

Many pretend they are filled with the Great Holy Spirit with showing signs in fleshly manifestations. Would falling out in the spirit provide proof that there is real power? Would speaking in tongues or prophesying tell others that you know God?

Would giving certain verbiage say that you drink real power from the Great Holy Spirit? What spiritual gauge can stand in the timing of powerlessness? Can one born-again Christian doubt another born-again Christian? How will the whole Church Body come into an agreement concerning church ways?

The laying on of hands transfers. Should there be an expectation? Yes. But can you gauge what spirit comes forward through impartation? What if that person who lays hands has various addictions? Can you carry in yourself their addition through transferring? Can you filter out a demon based on willpower? You cannot stop what comes forward when you willingly align with the one who leads the act itself.

With laying on of hands, the general rule should be that only those who have been proven and seasoned in the faith and filled with the Great Holy Spirit should transfer and impart.

When walking in a leadership position, make sure that you know the people working with you in ministry details. Seek God's will.

The laying on of hands transfers great power, with a real extension from Yahweh's Great Holy Spirit. Sometimes the surging power is within the one who walks in the office, and in other times, Yahweh brings a surging straight from His impartation that flows through the one who lays hands.

Let me share a brief story. Quite a few years ago, I went to visit a relative at the will of Yahweh. Yahweh told me to go and visit her and that I was to lay my hand upon her head. I did not think anything would happen. I was used to casual praying, where there was a hope that something might happen.

Yahweh said His will so clearly; I did not doubt the command. But I did not expect a tangible action from Him. Why pray when there would not be a longing for something to go well. But I just wanted to do Yahweh's command and said I did it, not looking for a transfer.

But the transfer did not come from what I had within. I went and laid my hand on her. For a brief moment, the action felt just like any other prayer. But then, from my head and through my hand, went a pulsating force. Not from a warm hand touch that others asked me if I felt when they prayed; this pulsating power came straight from Yahweh.

As He laid His hand on my head, I became the conduit for her. I was the spiritual tube for the transfer. I was not able to carry that level of power within my mantle at that time. I was not even out of the spiritual wilderness. I still had flesh to break off, and no church structure sent me out.

I barely understood the idea of ministering to others, yet Yahweh did not look at it that way. He needed a willing vessel who would obey Him.

Yahweh gave a powerful surging that I literally felt go from my head, through my body, and into the hand I had sitting on her head. I kept my hand there, just waiting for more clarity from Yahweh about what to do next. I did not know what was happening, but I still waited. Then she said she could not take it anymore; her head felt like it was on fire from the burning coming from my hand. She got up and started walking around.

I could not get over the action of being able to feel the transfer itself. It puzzled me, Yahweh doing something tangible. It has not happened again since that time, but more impartations are coming in Yahweh's timing. He set the craving so high for this type of spiritual engagement.

How would you feel if you were able to feel the real power of the Great God King Jesus? What would you do with that? Would you go out and buy new business cards and label yourself a minister, or would you humbly seek where Yahweh wants you to serve? The decision sounds so easy, but we as humans love to feel included in the real world. We love when others acknowledge us, but we have a hard time dealing with correction, judgment, and the call to repent from our sins.

We may even think that we no longer need adjustments to our spiritual walk because we have a leadership position and would turn down noses at those who would put us in our place.

I was reminded of something recently:

1. Never assume that no one can correct you. When a person tells you to repent, go to Yahweh, FIRST. See what needs to be adjusted within, if anything.
2. When laying your hands on any, do not give them a transfer of your fleshly way.

Laying on of hands must be viewed in the church as a true power way to prepare and give into a person that will be given a plan to walk into a new work level. Callings can be

given, but hearing the calling will not be how a person will move into their full position in Kingdom work details.

You may know that you are called, but you may not be ready to walk in that level of moving in Kingdom power. Just because you may have given one message from King Jesus, you cannot claim to move in the fullest way in your training that is greatly needed.

People leave churches with a sending plan into the way that may be given for their way, but they may not be ready for a long period away. When there must be a laying on of hands, make sure it really must be moved on in that current will (plan) in the Great Way. Give a strong exhortation yet give a "ready for war" way only when it truly is time. For when you send someone out for a new level in Yahweh's Kingdom and they are not prepared, they can end up being devoured.

There are also ways to transfer without being a plan to lay hands on any person directly. There can also be a transfer from one person into another, with objects. Transfer the anointing through any way that will hold it as a container would, and it will provide the same results based on if the Great Way wills it. You must look with spiritual vision. Store anointing in clothing. Store God's power in the natural to give out in real street meetings based on what Yahweh states.

Even though these are sign gifts for the building up of the early church, take a quick reading of how Yahweh transferred His great power.

(12) At the hands of the apostles many signs and wonders were taking place among the people; and they were all together in Solomon's portico.

(13) But none of the rest dared to associate with them; however, the people held them in high esteem. (14) And increasingly believers in the Lord, large numbers of men and women, were being added to their number, (15) to such an extent that they even carried the sick out into the streets and laid them on cots and pallets, so that when Peter came by at least his shadow

might fall on any of them. (16) The people from the cities in the vicinity of Jerusalem were coming together as well, bringing people who were sick or tormented with unclean spirits, and they were all being healed.

(11) God was performing extraordinary miracles by the hands of Paul, (12) so that handkerchiefs or aprons were even carried from his body to the sick, and the diseases left them and the evil spirits went out.

God will give His power to move a purpose into natural details. God will confirm His work without needing humans to push it. Lay hands on those King Jesus chooses. Lay hands on those Yahweh sends out into any field of work. Lay hands on those ordained. Lay hands to stir up the gifts. Lay hands to dedicate for service. Lay hands to bring healing. Lay hands to transfer. Lay hands with purpose. Follow God's will in this.
