

A MEETING WITH SATAN THAT IS NOTED

I was once afraid to walk into a cemetery because of horror movies. I did not have a way to know that it was really crazy to worry about dead people rising up out of the grave.

Who would raise the dead anyway? Isn't that only possible with the Great Way, or would Satan heal any, with fake methods that will cause many to believe the antichrist is the One True God? The antichrist will be a worshipped servant of Satan. It will be a terrible way on this earth for those who are left behind, having a way to walk in that level of fear.

Satan came to the cemetery to talk with me. I cannot say anything that would prove it. It truly is a real detail. Why would Satan plan a meeting with me? It was planned based on what the Great Way gave. That plan was to give me a new level of work details that have not been dealt with yet. Satan asked me why it would appear that any would support a person who can preach about a rapture happening.

I can preach about the Great King raising the dead out of coffins buried below the earth. Could the Great King raise the dead? Can God give life to any? The plan would be clear if you truly embraced the Word of the One who created all things. Scripture clearly states the dead will be raised (read 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18).

(12) I saw the dead, both great and small, standing before God's throne. And the books were opened, including the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to what they had done, as recorded in the books. (13) The sea gave up its dead, and death and the grave gave up their dead. And all were judged according to their deeds.

—Revelation 20:12-13 NLT

I know that the Great King can raise any dead person. I know He is holding all things together with His spoken Word.

The Son reflects the glory of God and shows exactly what God is like. He holds everything together with His powerful word. When the Son made people clean from their sins, He sat down at the right side of God, the Great One in Heaven.

Power—God has unmeasurable power. With such great power, would God be able to have people raised from the dead this day if they have been buried? Let's start with something a little easier. Here is a statement: God can raise a dead person who died just a few moments ago. With hearing that detail, can you embrace it?

Can King Jesus raise a dead person who just passed? Will it be easy just because a natural seeing is given? You can see, with natural vision, that the one who lies there is truly a real dead person.

A person being able to see a dead person would have doubts that the person truly passed away in the first place. Here is a personal experience: I had a friend come over to visit, and when talking, he told me that if he saw a dead person raised, if they were newly passed, he would doubt that they were dead. "It would leave doubts," he said.

But what if they checked his pulse and it was gone? Would you believe he was dead? Your answer would say, "Yes," but a heart would give a doubt, wondering, "Why would it be a real raising from the dead?"

—"They were just sleeping."

—"They were in a coma and woke up."

—"They weren't *really* dead."

Others would mock you for thinking it would happen. You would be the detail of a lot of jokes people make. Here is the reason why God wants to raise a person from the cemetery: There would truly become a standing way of great proof that God is real, has real power, and is Lord and God over death, in all realms and regions. No person can fake raising a dead buried person. I talked with Satan about how God wants to raise a person that way.

You have to know that any dwelling can become a territory of Satan. Why would cemeteries always be associated with Satan or Halloween or any demon-based dealing? The Death spirit makes its home, without any reservation, with all that are dead, in natural dealings. You have to see it: An actual Death spirit is holding all of the dead down in their graves till God overrules, to rapture through resurrection.

Temporary raisings take place. King Jesus raised Lazarus when He was on the earth. That was a temporary raising, for surely, Lazarus is a dead person this day. Lazarus was raised; then Lazarus died again. Lazarus will be raised again but with a different dealing; for when God ends the current Church Age, all will cease as we know it, and Death will be dealt with in a different way, where it will be thrown into the lake of fire for all eternity.

All can truly die, and even this day, God can raise any; but what price would have to be paid to be that instrument who speaks God's words to make a dead person live again? What price? God has given everyone eternal life if they will just receive it. What price would be paid to walk in this level of surging power in the Creator?

Wouldn't that person have to truly yield and only do what the Great Holy Spirit tells them to do? Wouldn't that person need to burn off selfish fleshly ways through regular fasting continually? Wouldn't that person have only to be faithful to God and never give any service to Satan?

Wouldn't God's instrument—His human vessel—wouldn't that person have to deal with being alone? Who will they share with, what God plans? Who will truly be able to have that kind of faith required to boldly go and raise any with the Great Holy Spirit's power in the name of King Jesus?

Who is ready to be turned into a joke? Who is ready to give their whole will into serving a God they cannot fathom would make them do things that would get them branded as a heretic? Who will say that they want that privilege to deal with Satan, battle witches, spirit travel, and engage demons as if they are flesh? You wonder who would willingly sign up for that level of work. I have the answer. I have been waiting to share it. I have faith that the power of the Great Holy Spirit can raise any buried person and shape them as if they were never under the earth. God has given me great faith. I am looking forward to all He will bring in this new season. How about you?
