

WHAT I LEARNED AT THE CEMETERY

I don't know how this is going to come across. I went to the cemetery the other day, at the Great King's will. He told me to go there. I was not sure why, but as I started to walk through the cemetery, I heard the Death spirit speaking to me, telling me to leave his territory. I knew I had a plan to be there because the Great King told me to go.

In the past, the Death spirit would welcome me, so to speak, where he would talk to me and tell me different things. This story may sound so weird to those who do not even believe there are spirits that cannot be seen, but this is a true testimony.

I went there, and I walked through the cemetery. And God told me to do something that I've done before, but this time was very different. The last time He told me this—He told me to say to specific graves to "Rise up in the name of King Jesus" —the last time I did this, I saw the graves shake at His leading.

Not the natural graves, but I actually saw where the graves were shaking in the spirit realm. The dead bones were shaking, trying to rise up, but they couldn't. I saw, in the spirit realm, the Death spirit was like a tree root that was lying over each grave, each coffin, where that dead person could not rise.

I wondered why the Great King told me to do that, to say those words when nothing would actually happen. And He was showing me what was taking place in the unseen realm, where death itself literally holds a dead person in place, where they cannot move.

So, when I heard the Great King tell me to do this again, He said to say it out loud. So, I said it like this: "In the name of the Great Way King Jesus: Rise up!" And nothing happened. Then He told me to say it again. So, I said it again. I said, "In the name of King Jesus of Nazareth: Rise up!"

Nothing happened, except for one thing: The Death spirit kept yelling at me, telling me to stop, and he told me that King Jesus would not allow it. And that puzzled me because the Great King told me to say, "Rise up out of your graves." Then, I found out from the Great King how detrimental that would be if He actually allowed it—if it wasn't just a training session.

At that moment, the Lord showed me the words that I spoke; they shook every grave. So, imagine if He allowed all the dead to rise. That would be a scary moment. The Death spirit kept yelling at me, telling me to get out of his territory. He was very angry, and I couldn't see why until I left.

As I walked off his territory, I felt a surging of power within me that I never felt before, where I could literally feel God's power, like electricity, as if He was truly pushing forward, His will, His work. And I could actually feel Him.

This account may sound so strange to those who cannot embrace this, but I tell you the truth, this plan happened the other day when I walked through a local cemetery.

I know that God can raise any, and now it makes sense to me why He called Lazarus by name because if He did not, the graves would shake all over the place. All the dead would rise. Imagine what would happen if we walked in God's power if we truly believed Him. But not just believing is required. He must have it be His will, where He wants it to take place. You cannot just go around saying His name, hoping that something would happen. You must say His name and have His will.

You must have a covenant with Yahweh. You need to know the plan that God wants to move forward with. And lastly, it must be moved into a real natural time when God says it's the right time. Having a covenant and knowing God's will is well to have, but it will not be made known into the natural realm and manifested if the timing is wrong.

Make sure you wait for God's timing. Those who abide in Him, He will bring forth that will, the plan that He wants—not what we pray for—because we could pray for anything, hoping that God would accept it. But we must pray His will for anything concerning any matter.

Whether it's concerning healing, wealth, family problems, or addictions, you must know the reason why something is happening. Don't just pray blindly, hoping that something gets done, hoping that something takes place in the spirit realm. You must pray with power, praying God's will. And knowing the timing of God's plan to manifest will bring great victory.

You have to ask the Great Holy Spirit what His plan is in that situation, in that circumstance, in that prayer meeting, in that laying on of hands. Do not quote Scripture out of context, hoping that it works for you. You need to know God's will, and you must pray His will. And the only way to pray His will is to commune with the Great Holy Spirit.

You need to have a fellowship with Yahweh. You need to have a relationship with God. You must not fear any demon. You need to truly believe in the One True God, Creator of Heaven and Earth, King Jesus. Believe that Jehovah can do all things yet pray His will.

Now, what did I learn? I learned that words are powerful, and Scripture shares that point. I also learned that God has a purpose for every part of the training, and you must go through that. Do not skip God's training sessions. Let God train you His way. If God tells you to go to a cemetery, then go. Go, and don't be afraid. Go out into your work field. Cast out demons. Heal the sick. Raise the dead.

Do whatever God commands. Go and talk to your neighbor about King Jesus. Pray for your family and coworkers. Tell your church members to take hold of God's plan. Live a holy life. Honor God in your giving. Whatever Yahweh says to do, do His will. He truly knows you better than you know yourself. My prayer is that God helps you to follow Him with unwavering love.
