

# HEARING SECRETS WITHOUT BEING PRESENT

## **YAHWEH LEADS THIS CONVERSATION:**

You heard a woman say that I should not have you use the photos from a few years ago due to how you gained weight and appear older than the photo. And in the same hearing, another who will be extremely jealous of your presentation is heavily influenced by the poison that the other woman gives out against you.

What made them turn to speak ill? You were already spoken ill of from how you were given governing authority over a person's funeral. That plan to give you the authority to take care of the details was set in place by the one who had the power claim over the deceased person. Were you at fault? No. But jealous ways do not think clearly. And you exude Yahweh, and the people turn to move in drinking your way.

Some think that you are off when it comes to spiritual hearing, and you heard conversations pertaining to that way. You heard another woman beg Me to let you keep ill-willed people attached to your mantle. She expected Me to let her and those others who continually speak ill about you when in their private chambers and not say anything about it.

How will it really be when you walk in the fullness of your work? Will you have many real friends? No. I will not let you get close to many. They will think that they will be able to drink from the work and the mantle due to being in company with you. Another woman has caused her husband to take in ill ways due to her poisoned way. We let you hear her deal with another wounded person who has hardened her heart against the idea that Yahweh is really with your way. Here is that first plan from the earlier giving in notes:

The bitter woman states, "Why would she think it would be okay? She should use a photo that looks like how she really is."

That is a general saying.

The soon-to-be excessively jealous woman states, "Maybe she is doing it just how others do and use a picture that makes her look prettier. Well, she is pretty, but she is pretending she still has a thin body."

The other woman, "She can think that all she wants." (scoffs)

See it; how can any person hear such ill comments and still love the ones who gave them? You see it, how We had to take you into those thirty years of training to be the person Yahweh created you to be. You see. We must be able to tell you anything and have you still be able to move forward and not carry ill feelings.

But Yahweh made you gain weight to see how others treat those who are overweight. You still have cute curves. You have a few rolls around your waist. I can see you smiling.

You know that you had to take on weight just as an actor would require to become another way. And that is why I had you say that it's now time to become your old self again.

One hundred and eight pounds is very thin. That is where you will return to. But you will not return to your novice prophet training but will take in a great surging that will give seers and prophets, witches, and warlocks a way to see you.

Can you now see it? This gift that the prophets of old used in their meetings with earthly kings is invaluable. And We train you on using this gift based on conversations We give you to hear. We have used conversations from family, acquaintances, enemies, and those you do not personally have a past with.

And We have confirmed that this gift is real; you overheard a previous friendship while they disputed with another. We let you hear the conversation as if you were there. And that person shared their dispute, and you noted how it was in sync with what Yahweh gave you to hear as if a tape was played back. Three separate encounters, and what I had you witness was confirmed.

But there will come a season where you will exude gifts of healings, working of miracles, and creative works. With the gifts moving forward, you will randomly hear conversations while thinking about a certain person. I will playback the time frame and have you witness that as if it's happening in real-time. The prophet will enter a conditional world-level work way to taste a deeper power. And We will let your husband feel this level of power so he will turn and embrace who you really are without the veiled filter.

Scripture reference: The prophet heard what the enemy said in private; the gift in operation.

(8) Now the king of Aram was making war against Israel; and he consulted with his servants, saying, "In such and such a place shall be my camp." (9) But the man of God sent *word* to the king of Israel, saying, "Be careful that you do not pass this place, because the Arameans are coming down there." (10) And the king of Israel sent *scouts* to the place about which the man of God had told him; so he warned him, so that he was on his guard there, more than once or twice. (11) Now the heart of the king of Aram was enraged over this matter; and he called his servants and said to them, "Will you not tell me which of us is for the king of Israel?" (12) One of his servants said, "No, my lord, the king; but Elisha, the prophet who is in Israel, tells the king of Israel the words that you speak in your bedroom."

Scripture reference: The prophet heard and saw what happened when his servant took the gifts.

(15) Then he returned to the man of God with all his company, and came and stood before him. And he said, "Behold now, I know that there is no God in all the earth, except in Israel; so please accept a gift from your servant now." (16) But he said, "As *surely as* the Lord lives, before whom I stand, I will accept nothing." And he urged him to accept *it*, but he refused. (17) Then Naaman said, "If not, please let your servant be given two mules' load of Earth; for your servant will no longer offer a burnt

offering nor a sacrifice to other gods, but to the Lord. (18) Regarding this matter may the Lord forgive your servant: when my master goes into the house of Rimmon to worship there, and he leans on my hand and I bow down in the house of Rimmon, when I bow down in the house of Rimmon, may the Lord please forgive your servant in this matter.” (19) He said to him, “Go in peace.” So he went some distance from him. (20) But Gehazi, the servant of Elisha the man of God, thought, “Behold, my master has spared this Naaman the Aramean, by not accepting from his hand what he brought. As the Lord lives, I will run after him and take something from him.” (21) So Gehazi pursued Naaman. When Naaman saw *someone* running after him, he came down from the chariot to meet him and said, “*Is everything well?*” (22) And he said, “*Everything is well.* My master has sent me, saying, ‘Behold, just now two young men of the sons of the prophets have come to me from the hill country of Ephraim. Please give them a talent of silver and two changes of clothes.’” (23) Naaman said, “Be sure to take two talents.” And he urged him, and tied up two talents of silver in two bags with two changes of clothes, and gave *them* to two of his servants; and they carried *them* before him. (24) When he came to the hill, he took them from their hand and deposited them in the house, and he sent the men away, and they departed. (25) But he went in and stood before his master. And Elisha said to him, “Where have you been, Gehazi?” And he said, “Your servant went nowhere.” (26) Then he said to him, “Did my heart not go *with you*, when the man turned from his chariot to meet you? Is it a time to accept money and to accept clothes, olive groves, vineyards, sheep, oxen, and male and female slaves? (27) Therefore, the leprosy of Naaman shall cling to you and to your descendants forever.” So he went out from his presence afflicted with leprosy, *as white as snow*.
