

TATTOO ART

They say, “do not mark up the temple,” but did the tabernacle have any engravings? Many say they think it is a sin to body tattoo your own skin, yet many say it is okay to go and pierce your skin and place metal objects, plastic objects, stone objects, and so on in your skin (ears, face, navel, etc.).

What makes your lifestyle a pleasing way? What makes you saved? What makes you have a spirit born-again detail, and does that true will in being with God end with a tattoo on your skin? Will you become a sinner if you pierce something? Will you no longer be a Christian if you were cut for a procedure? Then many women would be ousted due to these various details mentioned.

I have an ear piercing in both of my ears. I also have a tattoo. Based on these details, you cannot say you have a way to know me. You would not know me, in spirit ways, just based on looking at me, in natural ways. Fully yield in seeing that Yahweh looks at the heart. Humans look at outside appearances to gauge people; God looks at your heart—an area greatly overlooked.

Tattoo art can also take on a nature that gives Satan glory. And that will become a baseline that would make most rule having a tattoo as Satan’s work. But even King Jesus uses defining markings to display His way in position based on what is given in Scripture (ref. Revelation 19:16). Even King Jesus has deep piercings to remind us of His saving way for all who would drink (ref. John 20:19-29). Those piercings from the cross should not be viewed as sinful. We will look at His piercings in fresh ways this day.

Your body can have a way of honoring your God. Have a plan for moving into any detail with a base rooted in honoring to worship Yahweh in all you say and do. Pagans have their own ways of cutting, piercing, and marking up their way to appear unified with their deity. Have a way to walk in the Spirit and follow Yahweh’s Word.

Never pick a fight concerning such petty details. Your way must be one of moving in reconciliation that would unify the Body of King Jesus. Use your body to bring King Jesus great glory.

What will make it clear that God will use anyone? Who shall stand with me—tattoo or no tattoo? My heart will show God's nature, and I will be able to give you what He places in my spirit; for as it truly is written—that the Kingdom shall be within me—I will truly reflect it, to give out Yahweh's will and build up the Kingdom on Earth.

(11) Then I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse! The one sitting on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness he judges and makes war. (12) His eyes are like a flame of fire, and on his head are many diadems, and he has a name written that no one knows but himself.
